

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WINSLOW NO. 319
BYLAW NO. 7-2026**

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE IN
THE MUNICIPALITY**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Winslow No. 319 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No dog shall run at large in the Municipality and for the purpose of this bylaw, a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when it is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is not under control by being:
 - a) In direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or
 - b) Securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - c) On a leash which is under the direct control of the person who is in charge of the dog; or
 - d) Securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.
2. A person who owns, possesses or harbours a dog found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw.
3. a) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw, shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to a penalty of:
 - i) First Occurrence per dog: \$100.00 municipal handling fee and payment of all pound/kennel fees,
 - ii) Second Occurrence per dog: \$200.00 municipal handling fee and payment of all pound/kennel fees,
 - iii) Third and Subsequent Occurrences per dog: \$300.00 municipal handling fee and payment of all pound/kennel fees.
 - b) A violator of this Bylaw, upon being served with a Notice of Violation, may, during office hours, voluntarily pay the penalty at the Municipal Office within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date of service, and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not be liable to prosecution of the offence.
 - c) The Notice of Violation shall be in the form attached at Schedule "A".
 - d) If payment is not received as provided in Subsection (b) hereof within the time prescribed, information may be laid and a Summons issued. Thereafter, voluntary payment may be made before the returnable date of the Summons at the Municipal Office plus an additional penalty of \$25.00 if a Summons has been issued. Upon such payment, the person charged shall not be subject to further court action.
 - e) Service of a Notice of Violation or Summons pursuant to this Bylaw may be made by:
 - a. Personally delivery to the person committing the breach of the provision of this Bylaw; or

- b. Delivery to the last known address of the owner of said animal by registered mail.
 - e) A person whom a Notice of Violation is being issued pursuant to this Section shall, upon request, provide their name and address. Any person who fails to provide this information is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction.
- 4. That Bylaw No. 5-2026 is hereby repealed.
